Quick Start

1. Open EditReady on the Mac

VideoReady sends videos to NMD EditReady on your Mac.

2. Open VideoReady on iPhone/iPad

Allow access to Photos and the local network when iOS asks.

3. Select videos

Choose one or more videos from your photo library.

4. Connect to the Mac

Select the Mac found on the same local network.

5. Send to Mac

Start the transfer and keep both apps open until the Mac confirms receipt.

Permissions on iPhone and iPad

Photos

VideoReady needs access to the videos you want to select. With limited access, you will only see the items you have allowed.

Local Network

This permission is required to find NMD EditReady on your Mac.

Selecting videos

Choose one or more videos from your photo library. The app prepares the selected files before they can be sent. With large or long videos, this may take some time.

Finding and connecting to the Mac

1. Open NMD EditReady on the Mac

The Mac app must be active.

2. Check the network

The Mac and iPhone/iPad must be on the same local network.

3. Choose the Mac

Tap the Mac that appears in VideoReady.

4. Wait for “Connected”

Do not start the transfer until the connection has been confirmed.

Sending videos

VideoReady sends the selected files one at a time. During the transfer, you can see which file is being sent and follow the progress. After each file, the app waits for confirmation from the Mac and can retry if that confirmation does not arrive.

Large video files

Large 4K or long video files take more time. Keep VideoReady and EditReady open, stay connected to Wi-Fi, and connect the devices to power if needed.

If the transfer is interrupted

First check the network and whether EditReady is still open. Then reconnect and try sending again. Verify the received file on the Mac before deleting the original.

After receipt

The video is ready on the Mac side for further processing in EditReady or for saving to the chosen location. Verify the file in Finder or EditReady before deleting the original from the iPhone.

Important

VideoReady is the mobile sending app. To receive files on the Mac, you need NMD EditReady. Both devices must be connected to the same local network during the transfer.

No Mac visible?

Check Local Network permission and avoid guest networks that isolate devices from one another.

Troubleshooting

Problem	Check this
Mac is not found	Open NMD EditReady on the Mac; use the same network; allow Local Network access; avoid a guest network.
Not all videos are visible	Check VideoReady's Photos access in iOS.
Preparing video takes a long time	Large or long videos must be prepared first; wait until the app indicates they are ready.
Transfer stops halfway	Check the network, keep EditReady open, reconnect, and send again.
Large file transfers slowly	This is normal for large videos; keep both apps open and preferably connect the devices to power.

Always keep a backup

After a transfer, conversion, or export, always verify that the new file was saved correctly before deleting the original. For irreplaceable photos and videos, keeping a second backup is recommended.
